

CAMP INFORMATION 2011

• One day camp	2.30pm Tue 26 th July – 6pm Wed 27 th July
• Three night camps	2.30pm Mon 1 st Aug – 6pm Thur 4 th Aug
	2.30pm Mon 15 th Aug – 6pm Thur 18 th Aug
	2.30pm Mon 22 nd Aug – 6pm Thur 25 th Aug

- The one day camp is aimed at the younger rider who needs to develop their confidence and skills, or to learn new techniques
- The three day camps will cater for all abilities, from lead rein to advanced level.
- Children at all times will be taught to their own ability level. If you are unsure which camp your child should come to, please speak to JULIET. I will also try to group the children by ages, friendships and ponies available, so if you are available for several camp dates please let me know.
- Cost - One night camp £80 (deposit £30) Cheques should be made payable to Severnvale Ltd.
 Three day camp £205 (deposit £55)
- The above cost includes; all riding and stable management lessons; food; hire of school pony or a stall (if a stable is required then there will be an additional £15 charge) with hay and straw for your own pony. Children do not have to stay at night if they do not wish, but the cost of camp remains the same.
- A NON-REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT is payable to ensure a place at camp. Your place is not booked until a deposit is paid. The balance is payable no later than 2 WEEKS before camp.
- Severnvale reserves the right to change or cancel any but where possible will offer an alternative, if an alternative cannot be found then your deposit will be refunded.
- The camp will be set up in the car park. Children will sleep in 2/3 man tents in the field near the house if it is nice (or indoor arena or if its not!). There is a toilet and shower block on the stable yard.
- Juliet must be made aware of any medications required during camp with written instructions on dosage. All medication must be given to Juliet.
