

# Summer Camp Information 2021



Camp 1	3rd August to 5th August
Camp 2	10th August to 12th August
Camp 3	17th August to 19th August

This year there is a range of instructional camps for children to enjoy the thrill of owning their pony. Each camp is run over several days and will cater for all abilities, from lead rein to advanced level, and will teach each rider at their level of ability. So even if they have never ridden before and want to join in, they will be accommodated!

There are four camps of mixed ability; each runs under the professional supervision of qualified staff, allowing each child to receive valuable training in riding and stable management and lots of fun. The price includes lessons, food & stabling for your child's pony or horse or the use of a school pony.

## Camp details

Each camp involves three days of activities with lots of learning, lots of riding but most of all, lots of fun with our equine friends. Participants can develop their confidence and skills, as these camps are suitable for novice riders from age six years old, including those on lead reins, right through to more experienced riders. Including riders who can canter and are learning how to jump, through to those who can confidently jump a course and have a working knowledge of caring for their pony or horse.

These 3-day Camps start at 9.00 am each day and finish at 5.00 pm on Tuesday and Wednesday, but at 7.30 pm on Thursday, including a campfire, snacks and games.

## Costs

**The cost is £200** (non-refundable deposit £60 - cancellation fee may apply)

Individual days can be accommodated at the cost of £60 per day.

The fee for each camp includes all riding and stable management lessons, as well as food. Please note that there is no reduction in the camp fee if people choose to bring their food.

The fee also includes the use of school ponies or a stall with hay and straw provided for the participants' pony. If a stable is required, then there will be an additional £25 charge.

## Payment

- **General** – Severn Vale reserves the right to change or cancel any camp, but you will offer an alternative where possible. If an alternative cannot be found, then we will refund your payment.
- **Deposit** - This must be paid when booking, or the booking will not be valid. *This deposit is non-refundable*
- **Balance** – **All payments must be made in full by Sunday 18th July.**

- The Camp Fee includes; all riding and stable management lessons; food on each day of attendance; use of school ponies or a stall with hay and straw provided for own pony (if a stable is required, then there will be an additional £25 charge).
- Each camp will cater to all abilities, from lead rein to advanced level, and teach each rider at their level of ability. Even if they have never ridden before and want to join in, then they will be accommodated!
- If you are not sure which camp you should come to, please speak to Debbie, who will also try to group the children by age, friendships, and ponies. Also, if you are available for several camp dates, let Debbie know.
- **Cancellation** – If the participant cancels the booking, other than for a proven medical or equally valid reason, then depending on the period of notice given, the following refund of the camp fee that has been paid will be made:
  - Up to two weeks before the camp – full camp fee paid, less the deposit
  - Up to one week before the camp – 50% of the whole camp fee
  - In the week before the camp – nil

## General Information

- Debbie must be made aware of any medications required during camp with written instructions on dosage. All medication must be handed to Debbie.
- Children are NOT permitted to bring mobile phones to camp but may use the yard phone to call home. Parents are welcome to phone or visit at any time.
